## **Application process**

The specific school to which the student has been nominated ("reference school") will send application materials to the student (ACCESS EXCHANGE CODE REQUIRED)

The basic requirements include:

- Online application form (ACCESS EXCHANGE CODE REQUIRED)
- Photocopy of passport
- ID format photography
- Academic transcript of records
- Nomination letter
- Proof of Health Insurance
- Proof of English or Spanish proficiency (depending on the language of instruction of the specific courses). Minimum level: B2 CEFR
